NOTES:

The above financial results have been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS); as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013, regulation 33 of the SEBI (LODR) Regulation, 2015 and other recognized accounting practices and the policies to the extent, applicable.

2 The above standalone financial results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at their meetings held on 15th June 2021. The statutory auditors have expressed an unmodified audit opinion.

3 The figures of current quarter (i.e., three months ended March 31, 2021) and the corresponding previous quarter (i.e., three months ended March 31, 2020) are the, balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the end of third quarter of the respective financial years, which have been subject to limited review.

4 The Business activity of the Company falls with in a single primary business segment and there are no reportable segments.

5 The Management has evaluated the possible effects that may result from the pendemic relating to COVID-19 in the preparation of these financial results including the recoverability of carrying amounts of financial and non financial assets and based on its review and current indicators of future economic conditions, there is no significant impact on its financial results. In developing the assumptions relating to the possible future uncertainties in the global economic conditions because of COVID-19, the Company has, at the date of approval of these financial results, used internal and external sources of information on the expected future performance of the Company. The impact of COVID-19 on the Company's financial results may differ from that estimated as at the date of approval of these financial results.

6 The Parliament of India has approved the Code of Social Security, 2020 (the Code) which may impact the contributions by the company towards provident fund, gratuity and ESIC. The Code has been published in the Gazette of India however, the effective date has not yet been notified. The Company will assess the impact of the Code when it comes into effect and will record any related impact in the period the Code becomes effective, if any.

7 The Board of Directors at their meeting held on June 15, 2021 considered and recommended a final dividend of Re 1/- per share (face value Rs 10.00 per share) for the financial year 2020-21. Final dividend is subject to approval of shareholders.

8 Figures for the corresponding period have been regrouped/ recasted/rearranged wherever necessary to make them comparable.

Opinion
